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Michael Luke (he/him) is a faculty member at PolicyLab and an attending physician in the Division of General Pediatrics at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) and the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. He also serves as Director of Research of the Pediatric Hospital Medicine fellowship and Associate Director of the Community Pediatrics and Advocacy Program.

His current work focuses on implementing and evaluating methods of addressing social needs in health care settings and using population health strategies to improve care delivery for children hospitalized with asthma.
