Dr. Reddy's research interests have included community-based participatory research around racism in health care, disparities in pediatric sepsis, and firearm safety/injury prevention. Her career aspiration is to leverage her intensive care experiences to drive research and inform policy in order to reduce pediatric morbidity and mortality.

Dr. Reddy graduated Summa Cum Laude from the University of Colorado with majors in neuroscience and molecular biology and a minor in civic leadership.
