Dr. Revak has previously worked on an intervention to advance nutrition equity among low-income families through a home cooking skills program, as well as a quality improvement intervention to address period poverty among adolescents and young adults experiencing homelessness.

Dr. Revak received her BS in Biology at Haverford College and her MD at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. She recently completed her pediatrics residency training at CHOP.
