The Scattergood Foundation, in partnership with the National Council for Behavioral Health, has selected PolicyLab and Children's Hospital of Philadelphia's Positive Parenting Program to Improve Problem Behaviors in Preschool-Age Children (PriCARE) as a finalist in the 5th Annual Innovation Awards. Developed by PolicyLab's Joanne Wood, MD, MSHP, and colleagues from Safe Place at CHOP, PriCARE is an innovative, six-week group parenting program integrated into primary care that is designed to improve child behavior, strengthen parent-child relationships, and decrease stress among disadvantaged populations. If selected as winner of the Innovation Awards, PriCARE will receive a \$25,000 grant to continue addressing important behavioral health needs in the communities we serve.
