These youth and young adults face numerous challenges while navigating the transition process, which can lead to lapses in health insurance coverage and reduced access to necessary health services, among other negative outcomes.

A recent PolicyLab [Evidence to Action](#) brief summarizes research findings around patient, family and provider perceptions of the transition process, as well as policy recommendations that various stakeholders can use to address these barriers for youth with special health care needs.
